Order of acceptance of applicants

St. Mary's Parish School was founded in 1908, to assist families in their children's *total education*, with a focus on faith and moral development.

Therefore, families will be accepted into St. Mary's based on the following criteria in the following order:

- #1 Families who presently have child(ren) enrolled in the school.
- #2 Active Catholic families of St. Mary's Parish or other Catholic parishes in the area (Moscow, Pullman, etc.) whose first child is entering school.
- 43 Active Catholic families of St. Mary's Parish or other Catholic parishes in the area (Moscow, Pullman, etc.) whose child is entering Preschool, Prekindergarten and has sibling(s) in another school system and will transfer all sibling(s) into the appropriate grades of St. Mary's Parish School.
- #4 Non-Catholics, active in their faith, whose first child is entering school.
- Won-Catholic families, active in their faith, whose child is entering Preschool, Prekindergarten and has sibling(s) in another school system and will transfer all sibling(s) into the appropriate grades of St. Mary's Parish School.
- #6 Families whose members attended St. Mary's Parish School or St. Rose's Garden and are alumnae.

Families who believe and will fully support the values and spirituality of St. Mary's Parish School will be put on a waiting list. Acceptance will be based on space available.
